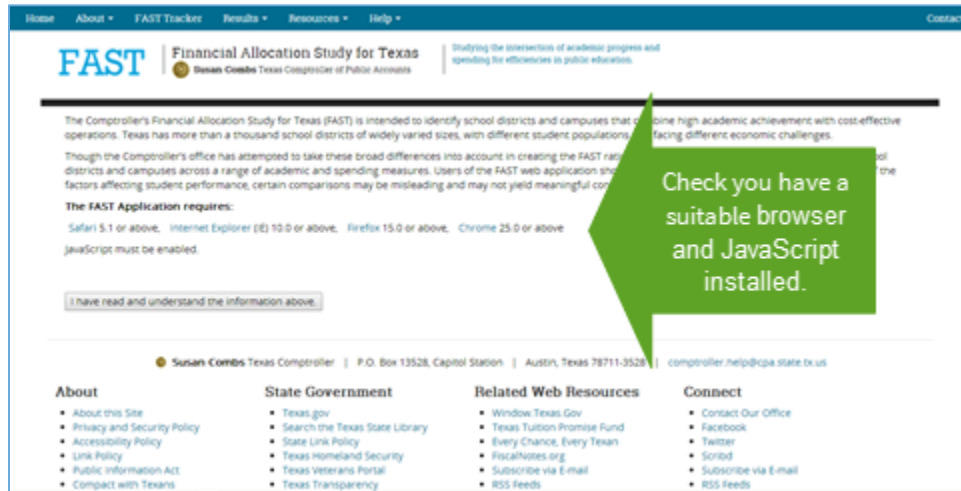


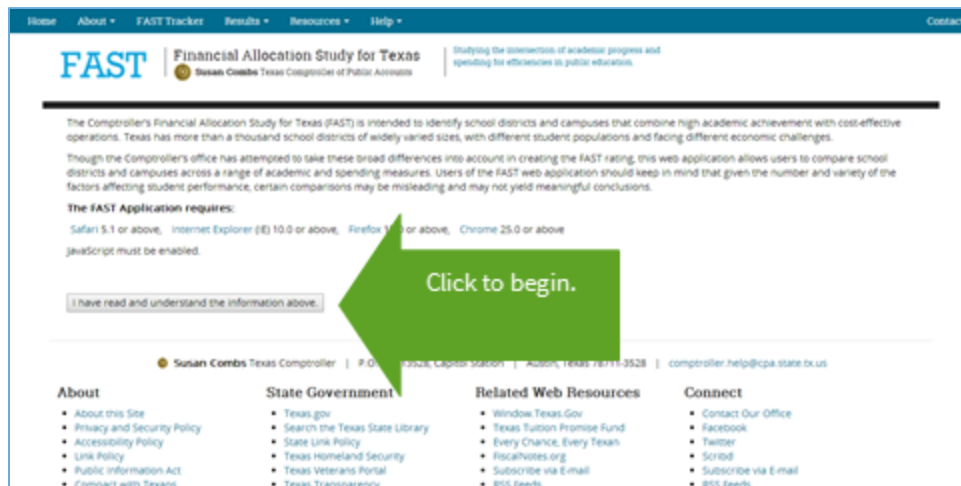
# Setting Up a FAST Tracker Search

In this video, we'll look at how to use FAST Tracker to search for districts that meet multiple criteria.

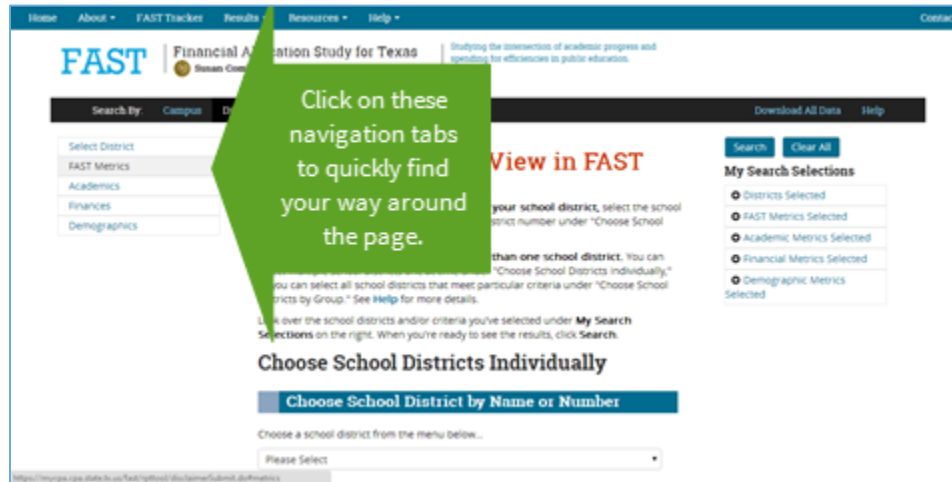
1. Before using FAST Tracker, make sure that your system meets the requirements shown on the disclaimer page. You must also have JavaScript enabled.



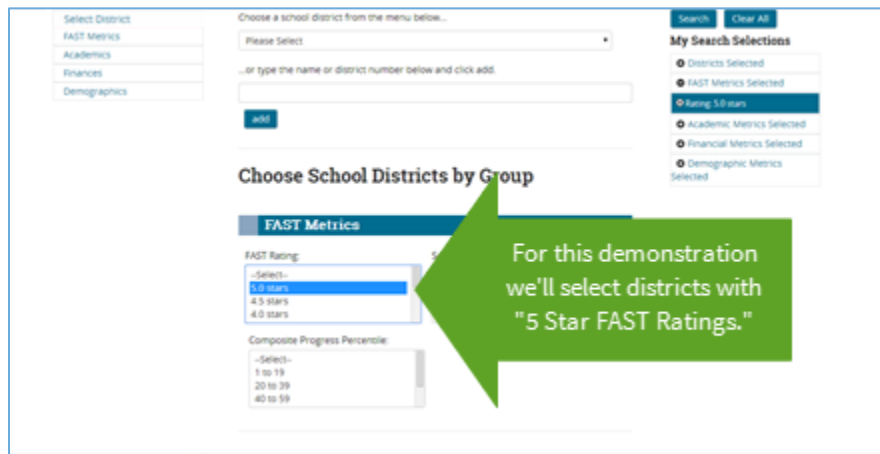
2. After you click the button to acknowledge the disclaimer, you may begin making your selections.



- We'll start by using the left-hand navigation to jump to the criteria we're interested in using for our search.



- We'll click on **5.0 stars FAST Ratings**. You can see your selection is now shown in **My Search Selections** on the right.



5. Next, we'll jump to **Demographics**.  
Let's further limit our results to 5-star districts that are also 50% or more economically disadvantaged.



6. Select **Economically Disadvantaged** from the **Demographics** criteria.




7. And click on all the bars from 50 to 100 percent.



8. Next, let's add an academic criteria. Let's limit our results to districts that received a "Met Standard" accountability rating from TEA.



9. We can now review the search selections.

We now have limited our search to districts with a 5.0 star rating, that meet the TEA Rating Standard and are 50 - 100% economically disadvantaged.

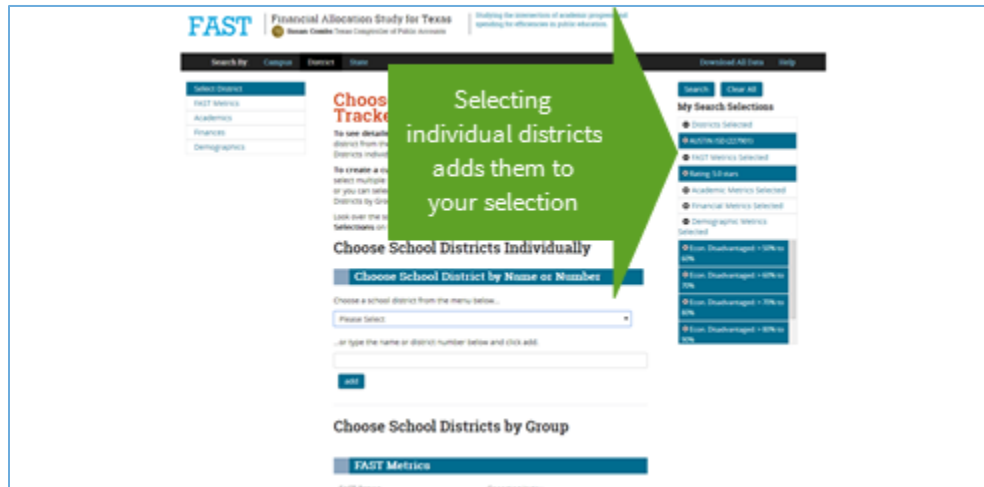
10. Maybe we decide we don't want the TEA accountability rating search selection after all. Just click on the X to remove the selection.



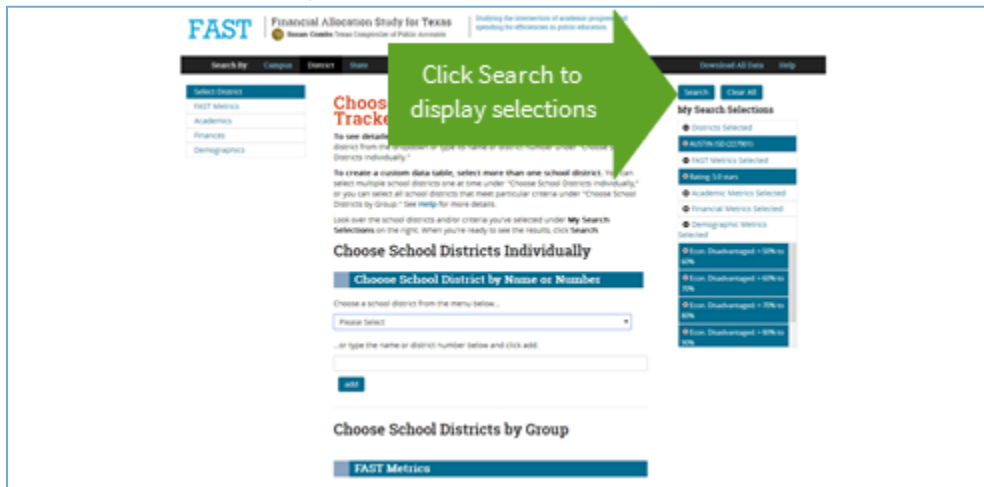

11. Individually selecting a district will add it to your search results, regardless of whether it meets your other search selections.



12. Now, we'll click Search to display the table of results, which we'll explore in the next video.
